

- NCTLD pediatric department for treatment of children between 0-18 year of age.
- Treatment of regular as well as resistant TB according to national guidelines and DRTB committee decisions.
- In Georgia, in total 12 patients have been enrolled in treatment with Delamanid compassionate use (CU), out of them 4 were under 18 years. 2 of them already finished their 24 weeks of Delamanid.

Infiltrative right pulmonary TB; new case, MDR, smear (+)







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Dlm need in patient D.N.

- Pre-XDR case
- Bdq couldn't be used because of the age (<18y.)
- Smear and culture conversion from 2nd month
- **BUT** poor X-ray dynamics
- Sent to Otsuka for CU request in May 2015
- 11/06/15 treatment regimen reinforced: Dlm-Lzd-Cm-Mfx-Cs-Cfz-PAS; => 10/07/15 Dlm-Lzd-Cm-Lfx-Cs-Cfz
- 10/12/15 completed 24 weeks of Dlm 24 => Cm-Mfx-Lzd-Cfz-Cs. Later Cm has been stopped.

Patient D.N.



- Positive dynamics on tomograms; remains smear and culture negative
- Continues treatment 17th month
